





Positions of influence






Parents in paid maternity/paternity leave by birthyear of child 2006




Average life expectancy at birth 1931-2006 85




Students at tertiary level in Iceland and abroad 1980-2006



Graduations at tertiary level 2005/2006




Population 25-64 years by education levels 2005
